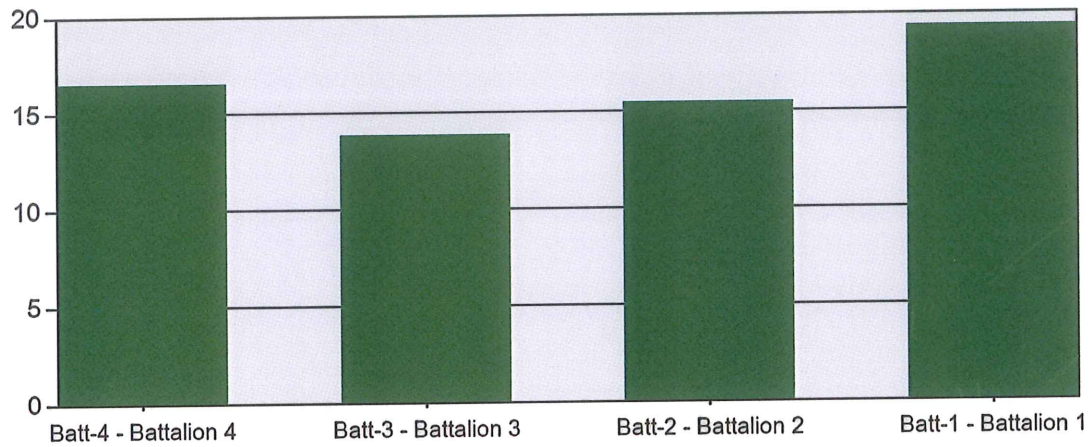

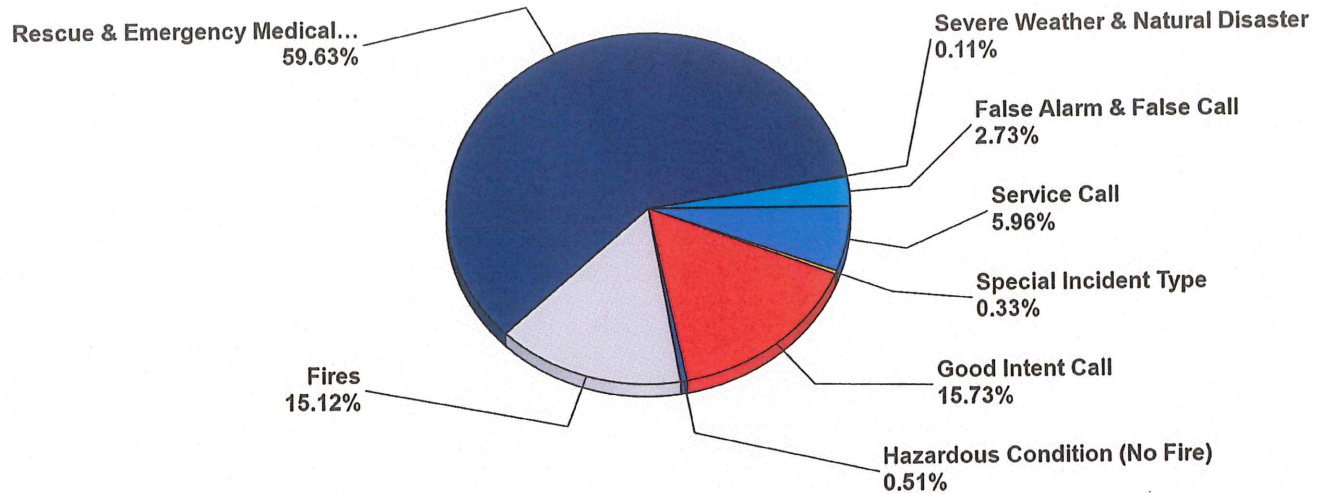

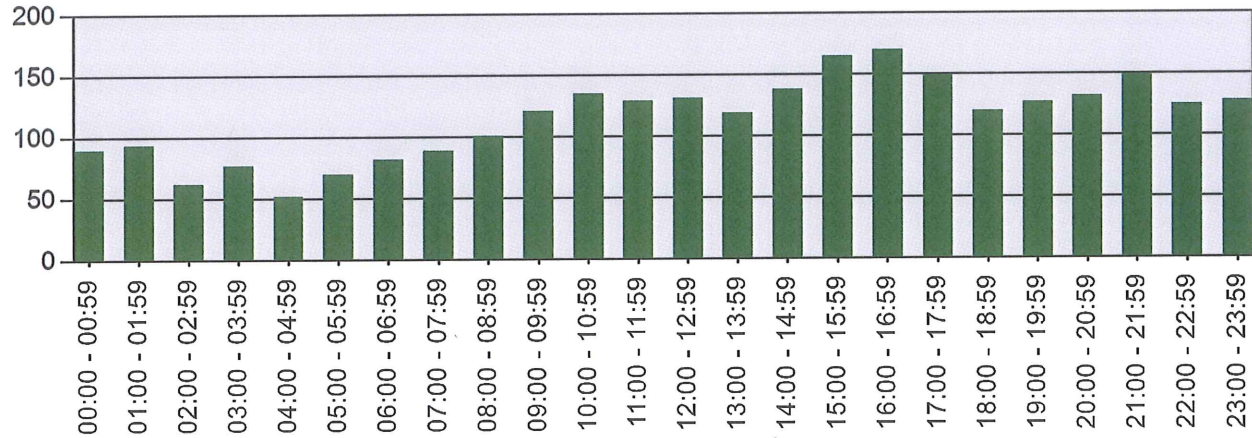

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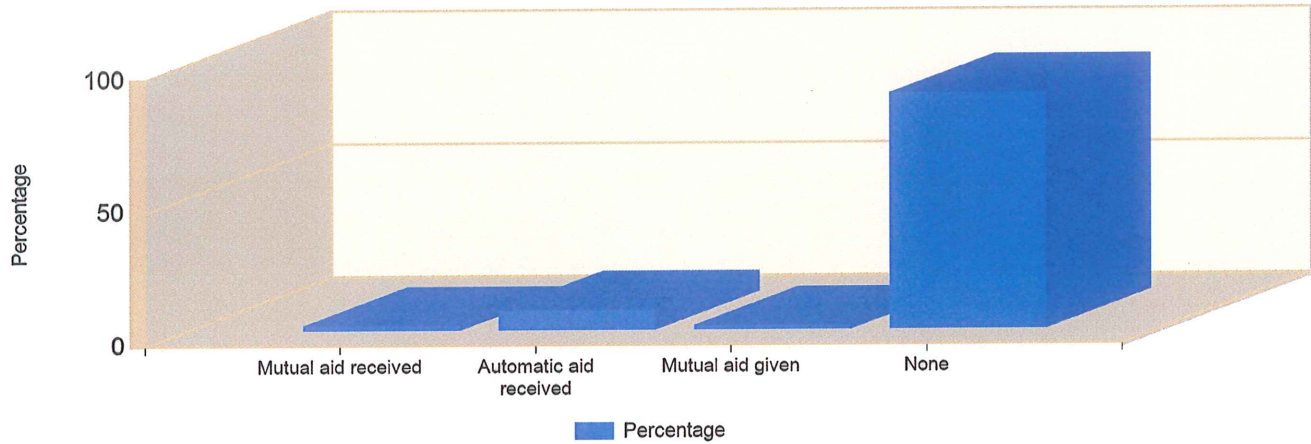
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Count of Aid Given and Received for Incidents for Date Range

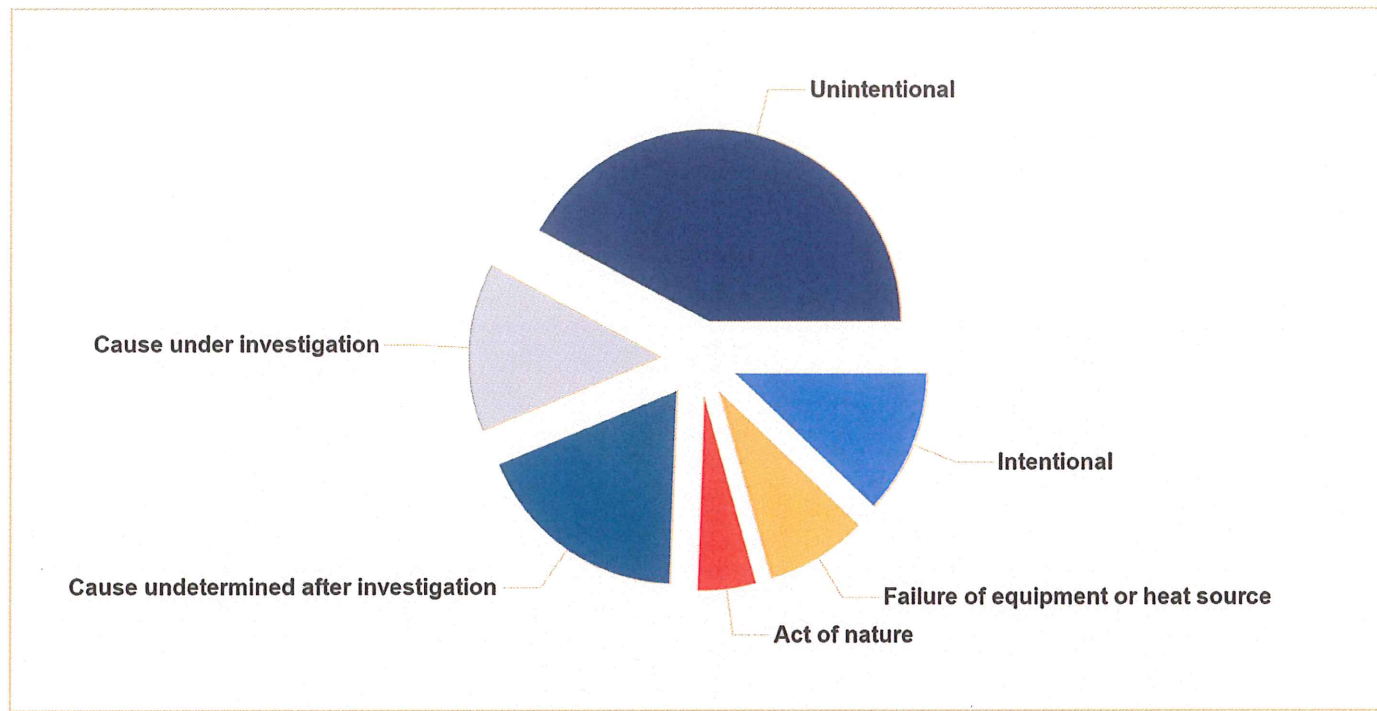

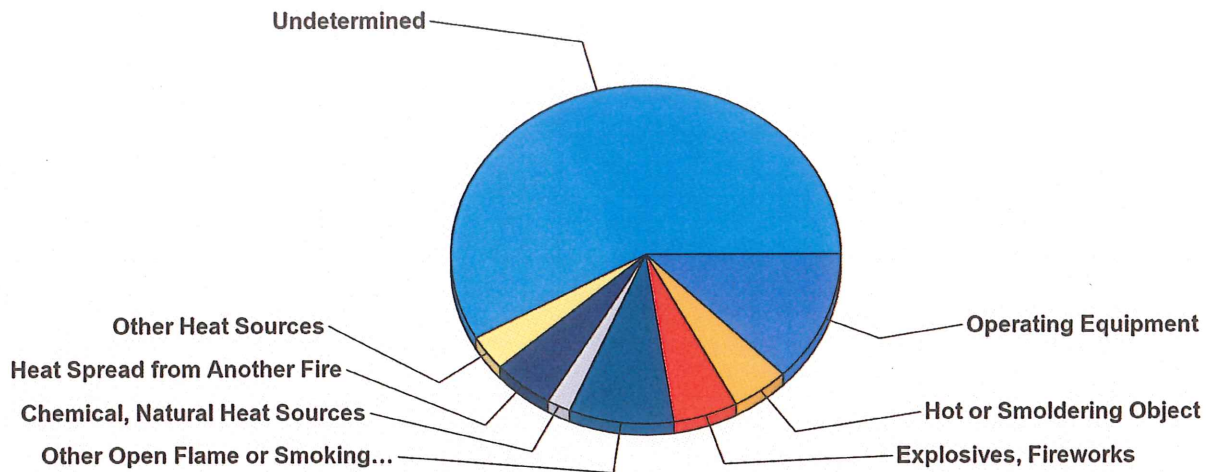
